Mrs. Clementine Fessenden, of Hamilton Was Its Originator and Foremost Advocate—Growing World-Wide. The founder of Empire Day was Mrs. Clementine Fessenden, of Hamilton, widow Canon Fessenden, therefore more a daughter of the church than of the empire.

Empire Day was founded at Hamilton in 1897, and Mrs. Fessenden was its originator and foremost advocate. The day was first observed in Hamilton on Sept. 26, 1897, and was then spread to other parts of the Dominion.

Synopsis of Canadian North-West Homestead REGULATIONS

Any one numbered section of Dominion lands in Manitoba or the North-West, excepting 8 and 36, not reserved for any person or the sole of a family, or made over to any person, or the extent of one-quarter section, of 160 acres or less.

Application for homestead entry may be made in person by the applicant at the local Agent or Sub-Agent, or by proxy, but, however, be made on certain conditions. An application for entry or inspection personally at any Sub-Agent's office, or by proxy, is not valid unless the applicant is accompanied by the local Agent or the Sub-Agent.
