

Profits of the Merchant Tailors Large Enough to Pay Better Wages—Open Shops Only a Bogey.

The executive committee of the Tailors' Union has issued the following statement:

"In the interests of fair play, and for the information of the public, the misleading and inaccurate statement recently issued on behalf of a few merchant tailors demands reply.

"The transparent attempt to trail a herring across the scuttle, by trotting out the old bogey—the open shop—an issue which does not enter into our demand at all, while it may appear to some as a fairly safe dodge, that will not go on the air, and that is the truth."

"Anybody knows that the ring-leader of this attack wants to discuss open shop in all its bearings he can be accommodated, together with the gentlemen who are secretly assisting him in an attempt to break up the tailors' union, and from whom he gets the most of his inspiration for the silly stunts that he is now indulging in."

"The question of the hour is, however, the responsible report of the tailors and tailoresses of the city of Victoria, that they now make a share of the profits accruing from their hard work, so that it may constitute a living wage, and not for an instant in any other way to interfere with their employees in the conduct of their business. Of course, if as a trick to gain a little sympathy for their cause, an individual or two, is determined to interject the oft-exploded slogan, as to our right to offer and perfect a public organization, and by some artifice means to induce all kinds of mutual benefit to join us, why then, we stand prepared to fight, and thresh this matter out all over again for their enlightenment and information."


