Synopsis of Canadian Northwest Homestead Regulations.

Any even numbered section of Dominion lands in Manitoba or the North-West Provinces, excepting 8 and 26, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person the sole head of a family, or male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section, of 160 acres, more or less.

In case of "permanence" the entry will be summarily cancelled and the proceeds will forfeit all priority of claim. An application for a homestead must be made in person. The applicant must be eligible for homestead-entry, and only one application for inspection may be received from an individual until that application has been disposed of.

Inspection for inspection must state in what particulars the homestead is in default, and, subsequently, the requirements to be met in order to be successful. If the entry is not approved, the applicant will lose any prior right of re-entry should the land become vacant, or if entry has been granted it may be summarily cancelled.

Coal.—Coal mining rights may be leased for a period of twenty-one years at an annual rental of \$1 per acre. Not more than 2,500 acres shall be leased to one individual or company. A royalty at the rate of five cents per ton shall be collected on the merchantable coal mined.

Placer mining claims generally are 100 feet square, entry fee \$5, renewable yearly. An applicant may obtain two leases to dredge for gold in one claim, the first for a term of twenty years, renewable at the discretion of the Minister of the Interior. The lease shall have a dredge in operation within one season from the date of the lease for each five month period. Royalty at the rate of 2 1/2 per cent on the net value of the output after it exceeds \$10,000.

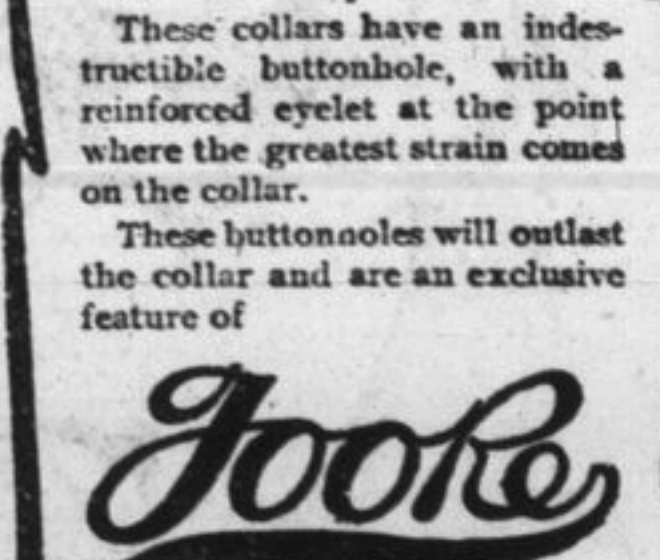
