OCCURRENCES RECOUNTED
IN BRIEF FORM.

Matters That Interest Everybody
—Notes From all Over—Little
of Everything Easily Read
and Remembered.

Five political prisoners were shot in
Hayti, Wednesday.
Rudyard Kipling will be the guest
of His Excellency Earl Grey during
his stay in Ottawa.
Capt. Bernier is in Quebec, with the
government steamer Arctic, after eight-
teen months in the northern ice.
Policeman William Kelley, Chicago,
lost his star and uniform when he ap-
peared in Judge Barnes' court with
tobacco in his mouth.
Dr. C. W. Hotchkiss, Erie, Pa., was
arrested, on a charge of arson. He is
accused of having burned his home
and office for the insurance money.
Barrister A. J. Kappeler, formerly of
Toronto, is the winner in a raffle of
the yacht "Alexandra," built by the
Vancouver Yacht Club, at a cost of
\$5,000.

Mrs. Annie Yeaman, America's oldest
actress, will retire from the stage
with the celebration of her seventy-
second birthday, on November 19th
next.

Prince Rupert's first born is a Japane-
se girl, whose father receives the
prize of \$50 and a cradle offered by
James Carruthers, Grand Trunk Pa-
cific official.

The estate of the late Dr. Ralph
Beckles, the Methodist minister who
died, in August, in Toronto, amounts
to \$253,187.68, mainly stock and se-
curities. Bequests are made to Meth-
odist institutions.

At the annual convention of the
Christian and Missionary Alliance in
New York, the missionary offering
amounted to \$65,006, those at the
morning service having contributed
\$35,643 of that sum.

Chicago, Oct. 17.—Forsaken by fam-
ily and friends and driven desperate
by thoughts of imprisonment in the
Harrison street annex, Mrs. Evaline
Romadka collapsed in Judge Sadler's
court, to-day.

Accompanied only by an attorney
and a private detective, the wife of
Millionaire C. J. Romadka, of Mil-
waukee, who confessed that she is a
burglar, was brought into court. Mrs.
Romadka gave a cry and would have
fallen had she not been supported.

As she was led from the court room
she stumbled twice and fell. The
doctors who gathered inside only
two to take her away.

C. J. Romadka, the husband, and
Clement Romadka, the brother-in-law,
failed to appear.

The case was postponed for one
week. P. B. Lucas, a negro attorney,
representing Jones, had the negro's
case, to whom the woman gave the
stolen property, set for the same day.

Lindsay, Ont. 17.—A specimen of the
