The girl's confession that she had blindfolded her lover under pretence of giving him a pleasant surprise and had then shot him in the mouth, leaving the body in a position suggestive of suicide, was wrung from her in connection with a charge of embezzling a friend's saving bank account of \$1,000.

The mother and another of the girl's lovers, a young Dresden merchant, named Merkel, have also been arrested on charges of forgery.

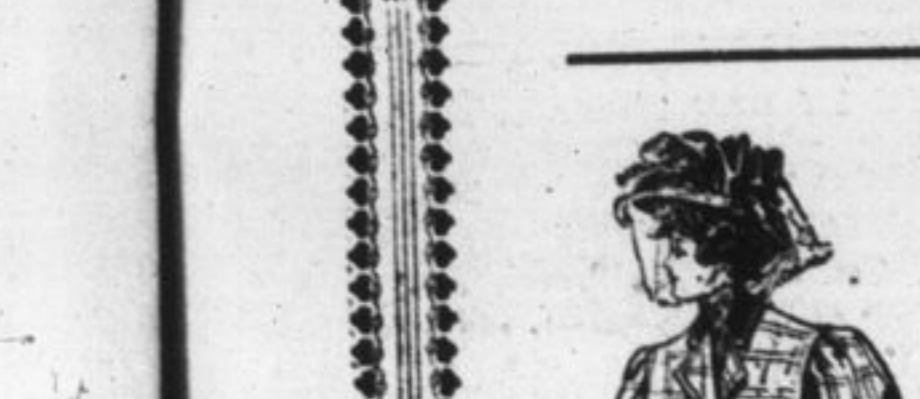
