



Any even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba or the North-Wes Provinces, excepting 8 and 26, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person the sole head of a lamily, or mail over 18 years of age, to the extent one-quarter section, of 160 acres, mor

Application for homestead entry mus be made in person by the applicant at pominion Lands Agency or Sub-agency betry by proxy may, however, be made at an Agency on certain conditions to the father, mother, son, daughter, brother er or sister of an intending homesteade As application for entry or cancella tion made personally at any sub-agent office may be wired to the Agent by the Sub-agent, at the expense of the applicant, and if the land applied for is vacant on receipt of the telegram such application is to have priority and the land wi be held until the nucessary papers t complete the transaction are received b

in case of "personation" or fraud th applicant will forfeit all priority of clair or if entry has been granted it will t An application for cancellation must be made in person. The applicant must t eligible for homestead entry, and only or application for cancellation will be r crived from an individual until that a plication has been disposed of.
