REFUPLED FRENCH

The Moors Were Very Busy at Casa Blanca.

Tangier, Oct. 23.—According to semi-official information received at the Spanish legation, here, the French forces at Casa Blanca, under the command of Gen. Hyaud, suffered a serious repulse, on Monday, at the hands of the Moors. Moorish troops, estimated at 7,000 and equipped with field guns and modern rifles, not only drove the French back to the city walls, but also managed to take to the extent that the French authorities found it expedient to request aid from a Spanish warship in the harbor to repel the attack.

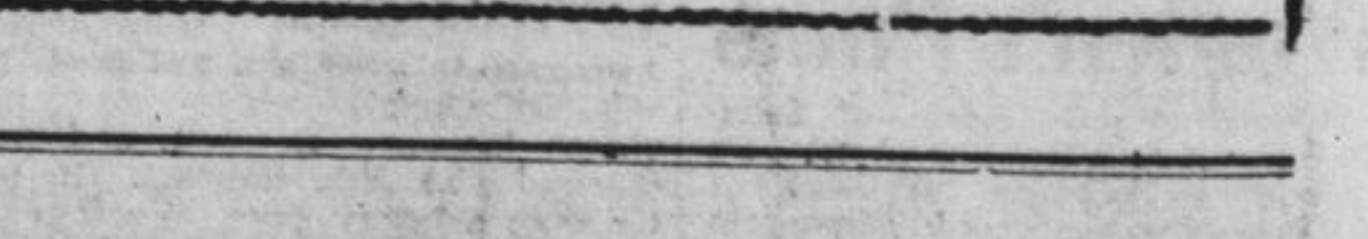
