Harry Kendall Thaw's second trial for the slaying of Stanford White will begin on December 2nd next.

The Royal Alexandra theatre, Toronto, has opened a new theatrical association, formed in New York.

The handsome edifice of the Orthodox church, at Westok, Alta., was burned to the ground on Thursday.

Five new wireless stations will be opened on the Pacific coast in January, Victoria station is ready to work now.

The provincial board of health is notified of one case of small-pox at Aurora, two cases at Newmarket and one at Sutton.

At Brandon, Man., a squaw who killed her husband in a drunken row, west of Minnedoua, on May 26th last, is on trial for murder.

The stern part of the new steel steamer Anasiboia, of the Canadian Pacific Upper Lakes steamship line, has arrived at Port Colborne.

The French government has given its approval of the projected English ferry boat service, on the American plan, between Dover and Calais.

The annual Thanksgiving day manoeuvres took place in the Dundas Valley. There were about 3,000 troops engaged. Col. Gibson's force won.

The population of Saskatchewan has increased 70,000 during the year. The homestead entries totalled 29,401. The total population is estimated at 325,000.

At Underwood, Ont., Hepburn Drummond, aged 100 years and two months died on Wednesday. Mr. Drummond was one of the oldest residents of Bruce township.

The first reports of the catastrophe at Karahung, Turkistan, were exaggerated, indeed, as fifteen thousand persons being killed, only about 200 lost their lives.

Enrico Scampano, director of a large factory at Monza, Italy, and the pope's favourite nephew has been shot by a discharged workman. The murderer was arrested.

At Brockville, on Thursday, Brockville defeated Gananoque in a junior O.R.E.U. match by 17 to 0, and won the extra round by 4 points.

The score in Gananoque, being 18 to 5. Captain Granville B. Fortescue, United States army, retired, has accepted from Governor Magoon a commission to carry out the duties of special instructor to the Cuban forces.

At Columbus, O., Royal Fowler, of Dayton, who killed his sweetheart, Mary Haggerty, more than a year ago was executed by electricity in the annex of the Ohio penitentiary just after midnight.

Andrew Carnegie having positively refused to contest his election to the magistracy, Lord Ashbury, this morning was formally declared to have been elected rector of the University of St. Andrew's.

Advices received from various sections of New England, tend to show that Raymond Hitchcock, the fugitive comedian, is bound for Canada. Some of his friends think he has met with foul play.

British newspapers in China are trying to force the British government to interfere in the Chinese customs department, the management of which was recently relinquished by Sir Robert Hart.

Mrs. Henry M. Leonard, Rochester, N.Y., the young mother who, on Thursday afternoon, tried to kill herself and two children, died Friday morning. Her ten months' old baby also will die.
