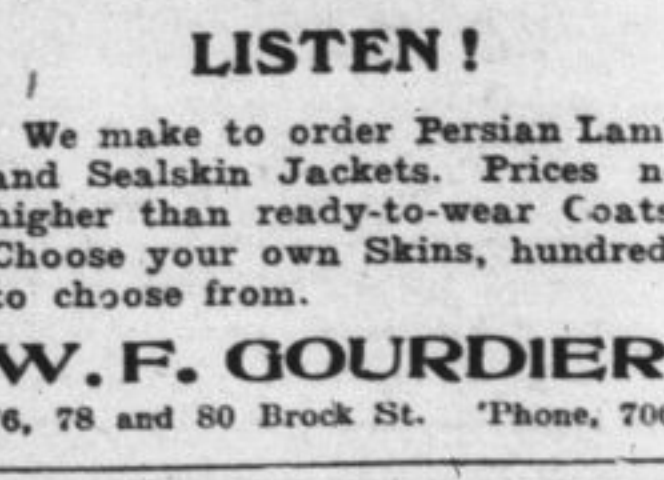

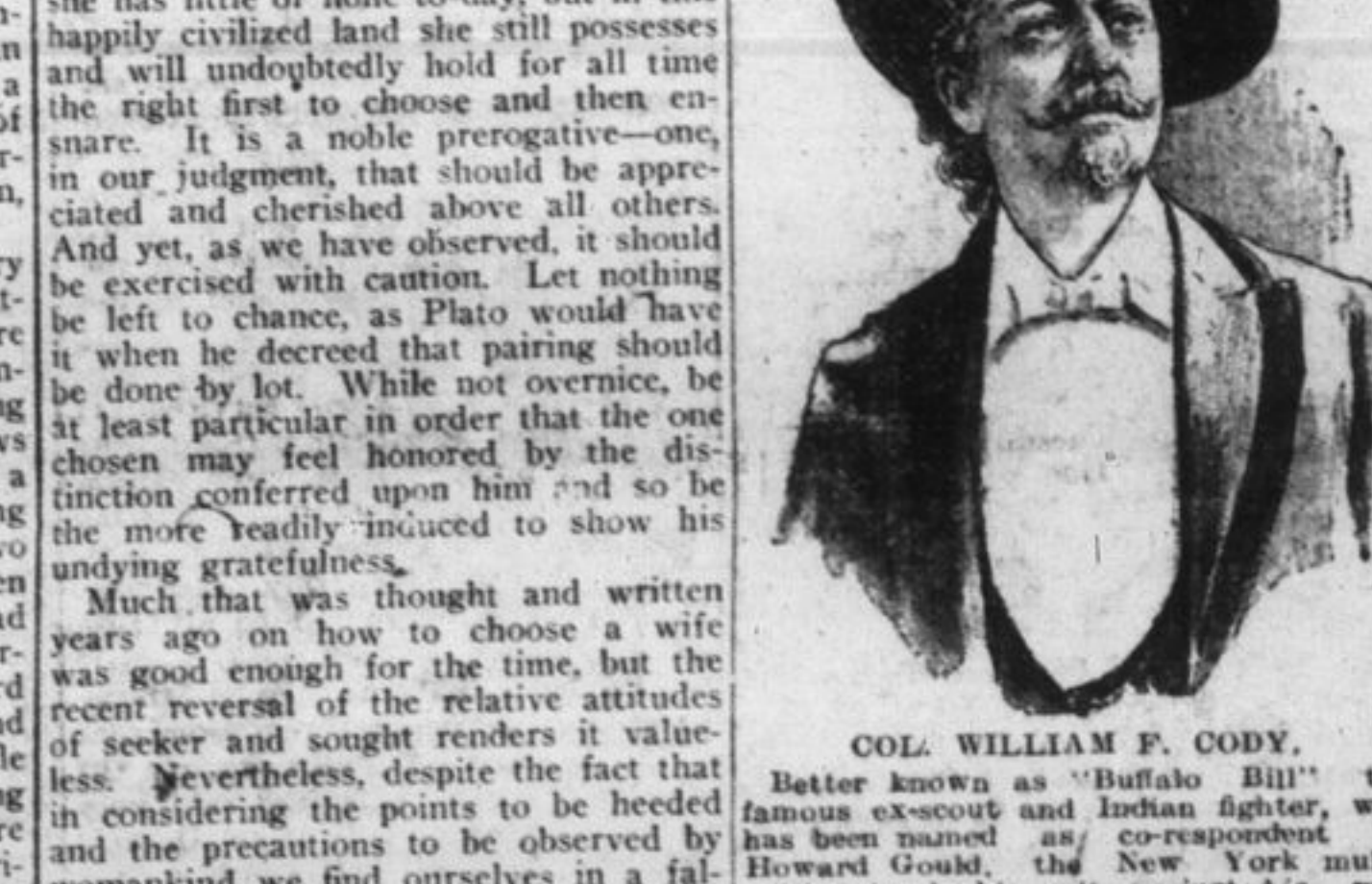
SERIOUS EXPLOSION

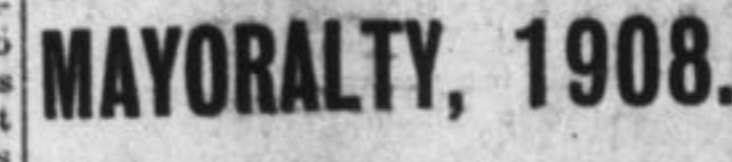

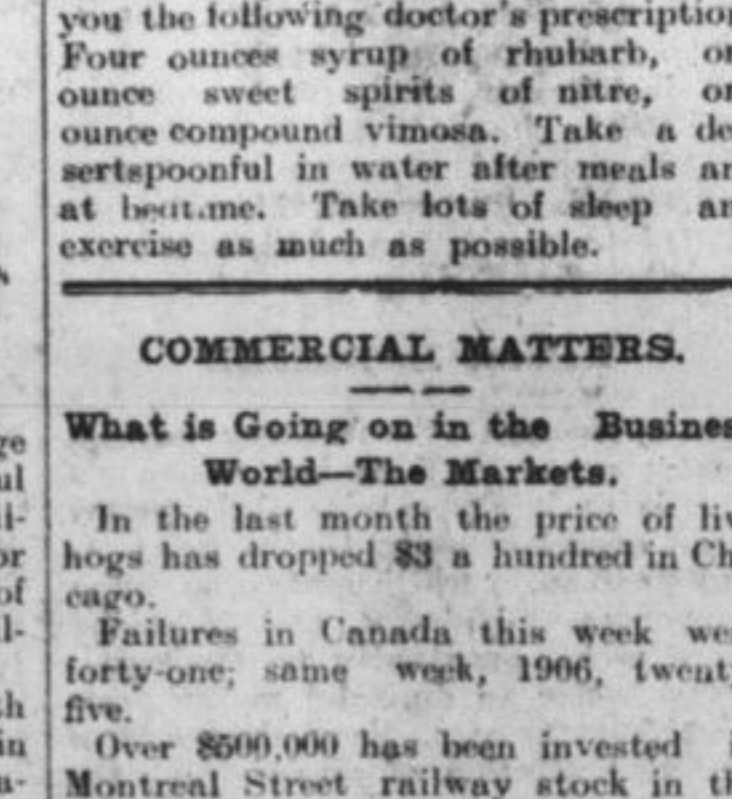
