QUEBEC BRIDGE.

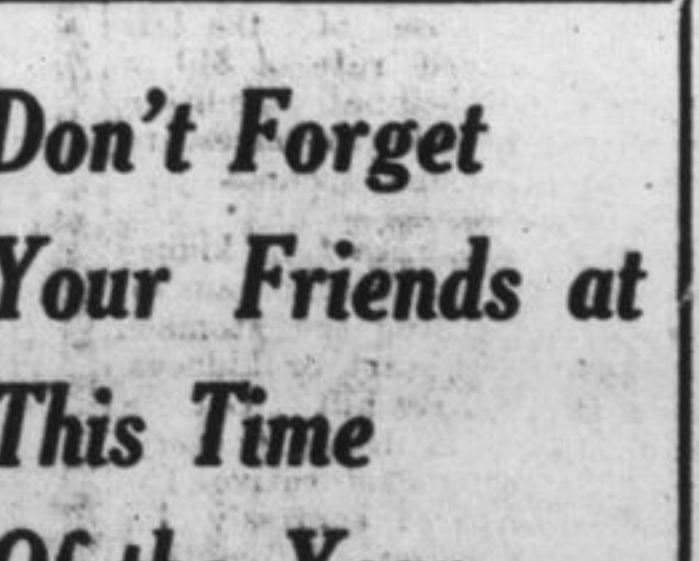
Effort To Hold Government Responsible For Disaster.

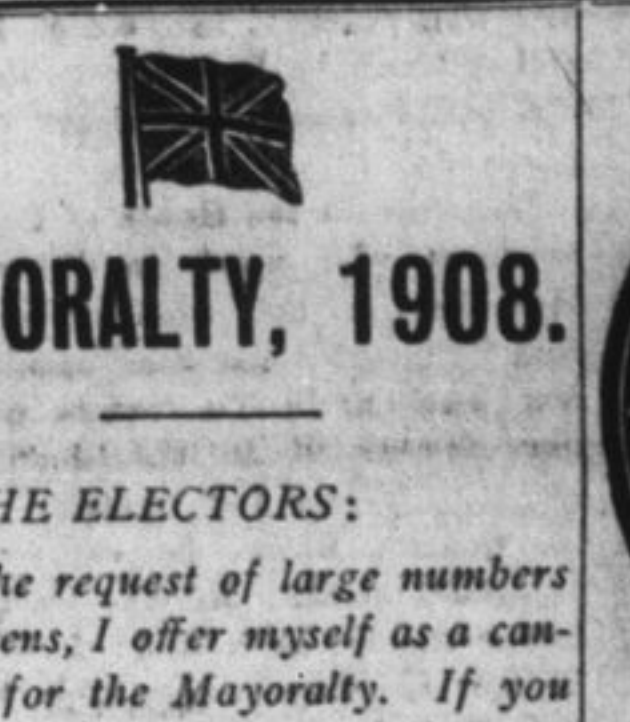
