REARING A TOKEN
THE WHOLE WORLD'S TOTAL OF TELEPHONES
Growth of Thirty Years Since Dr. Bell and Miss Katie Field Introduced Invention to Great Britain—Five-Eighths of All Telephones in North America.
The efforts of the Bell Telephone Memorial Association to secure an adequate monument for Alexander Graham Bell at Brantford, Ont., where many of the preliminary studies leading to the invention of the telephone were made, has given Canada a renewed interest in the progress of the great industry which has been built upon Dr. Bell's original discovery that sound can be projected by means of electrical transmission. A little more than thirty years have passed since the introduction of the telephone into Canada as a commercial utility. It is in just thirty years ago this winter since Dr. Bell and that vigorous American journalist, Miss Katie Field, gave exhibitions of the newly devised apparatus to wondrous crowds in Great Britain. There was recently put on exhibition in the Boston, Massachusetts, public library a collection of autograph letters made by Miss Field, among which several relate to interesting experiences as promoter of the telephone in the days when few people had any idea of the importance of the invention. One particularly entertaining letter is from Lord Beaconsfield, descriptive of Queen Victoria's delight at the idea of being able to talk at long distance. This note is as follows:
10, Downing street, Whitehall, January 19th, 1878.
"Madam—Her majesty the queen expresses so much interest in the telephone that His Noble Lordship of Foreign Affairs suggests that a trial of this invention be made in the private parlours of the Home Office, Downing street, on Friday morning, at 11 o'clock. The Earl of Beaconsfield concurs. You are hereby invited to be present, and if you are disposed to sing some selection to be transmitted from the library over the wires His Lordship would be obliged with the favor—With Respect, Madam, I am, yours, etc. (Signed) BEAUCONSFIELD."
"To Miss Katie Field."
From this crude beginning the telephone has been developed by successive inventions such as those of the switchboard, the circuit of hard-drawn copper wire, the bridging bell, the repeater and the loading coil until at the present date, according to a reliable estimate, there are nearly, if not quite, 3,000,000 telephones in operation in the world. At the end of 1906 the total number was calculated on the basis of reports from various countries to be in excess of 7,200,000, so that if the rate of increase observable for several years past has continued, as there is every reason to believe it has, there should be at least 8,000,000 at the end of the present year.
The North American continent, including, of course, the Dominion of Canada, continues to be by far the largest user of the telephone. More than five-eighths of all the telephone instruments in the world are to be found on this continent. The Bell companies of the United States had at the beginning of the present year rather more than 3,000,000 subscribers, while an estimate based upon
