SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTHWEST HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS.

Any even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba or the North-West Provinces, excepting such as are reserved, may be homesteaded by any person the sole head of a family, or male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section, of 160 acres, more or less.

Application for homestead entry must be made in person by the applicant at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-agency. Entry by proxy may, however, be made at an Agency or Sub-agency, by the father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of an intending homesteader.

Where an entry is made subsequent to institution of cancellation proceedings, the applicant for cancellation will be entitled to prior right of entry.

A homesteader whose entry is not the subject of cancellation proceedings may be subject to the approval of Department, relinquishing it in whole or in part, if eligible, but to no one else, on filing of a notice of withdrawal.

1. At least six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year during the term of three years.

2. A homesteader who, at the expiration of the term of three years, desires to perform the required residence duties by living on farming lands owned solely by him, not less than eighty acres in extent, in the vicinity of his homestead, if such a tract of land will not meet this requirement.

3. If the father or mother, if the father is deceased, or homesteader has permanent residence on farming land owned solely by him, not less than eighty (80) acres, obtained therefor, after the month from the first publication thereof in the British Whig newspaper, the date of which first publication will be the 9th day of DECEMBER, 1907; and that at the hour, day and place therein fixed for taking the votes of the electors, polls will be held.
