RABIES CURSE TO INDIA. MALADY CLAIMING MANY VICTIMS AMONG THE NATIVES.

Grim Terror Comes From Many Sources—Pasteur Institute Filled With Horror-Stricken Patients—Strange Sights in Operating-Room—Agony of Incubation—Method of Treating Awful Disease.

A writer in "Blackwood" gives his experiences of a dog bite at the Pasteur Institute of India, Kasauli, where he underwent the treatment. India is the land of strange and sudden death, he says. It offers you variegated facilities. You may be eaten by a tiger, bitten by a cobra, mauled by a leopard, bitten by a dog, mangled by a baboon, or stung by a scorpion.

The curse of rabies is on the city and on the village. Rabies—sporadic and epidemic—rages everywhere. Daily this appalling malady claims victims from Tuticorin to Peshawar; daily men, women, and children, white and black, bitten by dogs, cats, mad wolves or jackals, mad horses or camels—sometimes, horrible to relate, by rabid fellow-humans—speed to Kasauli for treatment.
