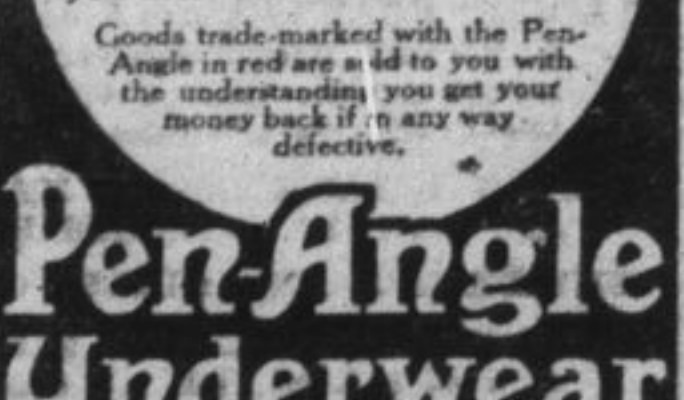

Antwerp, Jan. 20.—After spending two years in a cage in a Turkish prison, guarded day and night, and fed on bread and water, Edward Joris is back in his native Belgium.

When Joris, a very sick man, was brought ashore at this port the other day he asked his attendants to sit him down upon the ground so that he might kiss the soil of Belgium.

"I saw him a day or two afterward at his house, and he told me something of his horrible experiences.
