HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS. Any even numbered section of Domin-Lands in Manitoba or the North-West Provinces, excepting 8 and 26, not resole head of a family, or male over 18 years of age, to the extent of bne-quarter section, of 160 acres, more or less.

Application for homestead entry must be made in person by the applicant at a Jominion Lands Agency or Sub-agency. entry by proxy may, however, he made t an Agency on certain conditions by the father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of an intending homesteader. An application for entry or cancellacion made personally at any sub-agent's office may be wired to the Agent by the Sub-agent, at the expense of the applicant, and if the land applied for is vacant receipt of the telegram such application is to have priority and the land will e beld until the necessary papers to ete the transaction are received by

Paying For Boxer Outbreak. New York, Jan. 29.-The committee on reference and counsel, representing the Protestant missionary boards and societies in the United States and Canada, made public a statement concerning the indemnity claims of missionaries and missionary boards for losses during the Boxer outbreak in China. The entire amount paid out by the United States government for all claims that were presented was \$2,000,000. In this connection Washington press despatches state that the most exo oitant claims were those of the wive of missionaries.
