IS THERE A CHANCE OF KINGSTON GETTING CHEAPER POWER?

J. M. CAMPBELL SAYS THERE IS NONE AT PRESENT—THE CITY COUNCIL WILL DISCUSS THE MATTER—IT'S A MOST IMPORTANT QUESTION.

Unfortunately, the distance of any available water power is so great and the fixed charges on long transmission lines are so heavy that at present I do not see how Kingston can obtain any very cheap power.

This conclusion of John M. Campbell, Kingston's light plant expert adviser, will receive the consideration of the city council at its meeting on March 3rd. According to Mr. Campbell, the outlook at present for cheap power for Kingston is anything but promising.

The last figures which the commission supplied for Kingston depended upon what power Belleville and Deseronto would take. The lowest of these figures was \$24.81 a horse-power for twenty-four hours.
