Any even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba or the North-West Provinces, excepting 3 and 26, not reserved, may be surveyed by any person the sole head of a family, or male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section, 160 acres, more or less.

COAL—Coal mining rights may be leased for a period of ten years, not exceeding 100 acres, for \$1 per acre, not more than 2,000 acres shall be leased to one individual or partnership.
