SCANDALOUS SPECTACLE

Caused By Unworthy Immigrants
at Oshawa.

Bowmanville News.

Inspector Peter Devlin, deporting of-

fice of Kingston, arrived in Oshawa,

on Tuesday afternoon, for the purpose

of arresting number of undesirable

immigrants, and, on Wednesday night's

express seven families and their chil-

dren, numbering thirty in all, left for

Montreal. They will be kept at the

Detention Hospital, Montreal, until

transportation can be arranged by the

dominion government with the ship-

ping companies which brought these

undesirable immigrants to Canada.

Although these immigrants have been

kept all the winter by the kind hearted

people of Oshawa and surroundings,

and not allowed to want, when asked by the authorities to earn a

living, flatly refused to do so. This

caused difficulty and discontent among

those immigrants who are willing to

assist in tiding over the present cri-

sis, and something had to be done to

prevent a general rebellion. These

agitators were picked out and recom-

mended to the dominion government

for deportation. All these thirty per-

son were undesirables, yet kind people

of Oshawa would not let them be sent

away in want of clothing. Boots and

clothing were supplied, and we were

sure to say some of them never before

had as good an outfit. Almost all

their countrymen were at the junction

to wish them bon voyage. The shout-

ing and filthy language indulged in

was shocking. The presence of so

many women appeared to have no de-

tressing effect on the issue's shameful

expressions. Such a scandalous spec-

acle was never before seen here, and

it was abundantly evident that no

mistake had been made in selecting

those to be deported. The shouting

was not confined to the departing

ones, but was indulged in by others

who, apparently, should have been

brought along. Chief Constable Hind,

who had worked night and day for

months to make the destitute immi-

grants comfortable, was jeered and

hooted at dozens joining in the bawl,

who one more gratitude than they

can ever repay. The whole occu-

rence was disgraceful and will tend

to injure the many immigrants who

aim to become worthy citizens of Cana-

ada. Inspector Devlin thanked the local

police for their assistance, and said

he would take great pleasure in re-

porting to the dominion government on

the splendid arrangements here for

relieving distress resulting from over-

immigration.
