COAL—Coal mining rights may be cased for a period of twenty-one years at an annual rental of \$1 ser acre. Not more than 2,560 acres shall be leased to one individual or company. It royalty at the rate of five cents per ton sall be sollected on the merchantable com ined QUARTZ—A person eighteen years are or over, having discovered mineral is piace, may igcate a claim 1,500x1,500 feet.

The fee for recording a claim is \$5.

At least \$100 must be expended on the laim each year or paid to the mining ecorder in lieu thereof. When \$500 has seen expended or paid, the locator may pos having a survey made, and upon homplying with other requirements, purhase the land at \$1 per acre.

The patent provides for the payment of a royalty of 2; per cent on the sales. Placer mining claims generally are 100 feet aquare; entry fee \$5, remewable year-ty.
