### INDEPENDENT CRITICS.

The Star of Montreal, and the Herald of Hamilton, have, by their criticism of the budget speech shown themselves to be genuinely independent.

The Star is not politically an admirer of the liberal government. Its proprietor is a conservative who has given largely of his income in financing the elections of his friends.

The Quebec bridge is in the same category, and the government will recognize its responsibilities by seeing that the work is carried on in the most careful and satisfactory way.

Even the Toronto World, conservative, declares that "the bare fact that a deficit can be created by the inclusion of capital expenditure in revenue accounts cannot be used as evidence that the country is financially in a bad way."

It is for the Toronto News, which was founded under a new dynasty to show how a truly independent paper should treat public questions, to stand alone in his general condemnation of the Laurier government.

FOSTER'S KIPS A CCG. The weakest point in Mr. Foster's criticism of the budget speech was a rash thing in touching the reserves of the people without their knowledge and consent.

What could the government do? The reserves were all it had at its command. The surplus of revenue over expenditure account was going largely into the Transcontinental road.

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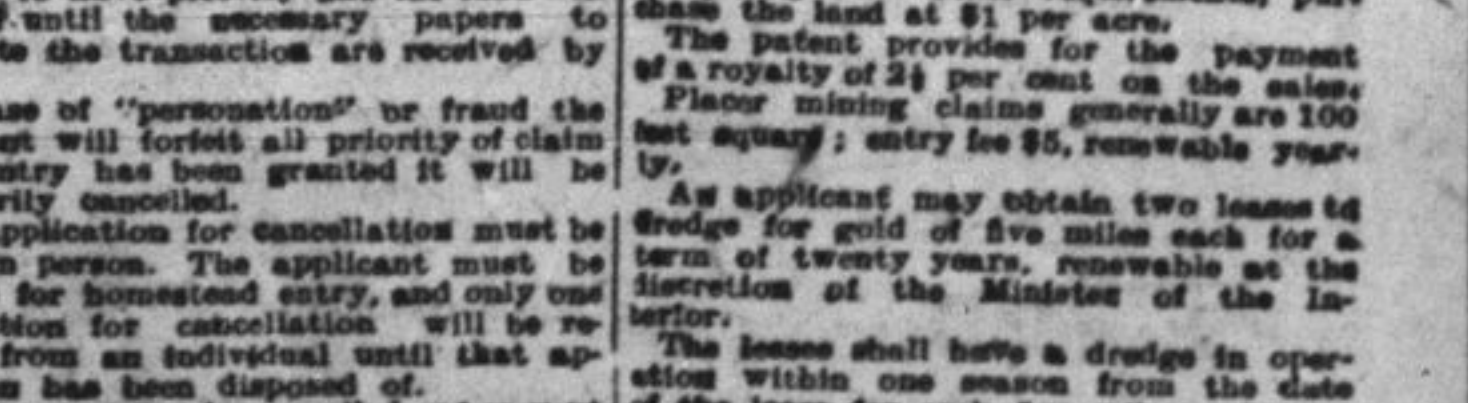
