

Synopsis of Canadian Northwest HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS.

Any even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba or the North-West
Provinces, excepting 8 and 26, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person the sole head of a family, or male
pver 18 years of age, to the extent of
one-quarter section, of 150 acres, more
or less.

Application for homestead entry must Application for homestead entry must be made in person by the applicant at a Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-agency. Entry by proxy may, however, be made at an Agency on certain conditions by the father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of an intending homesteader.

An application for entry or cancellation made personally at any sub-agent's pince may be wired to the Agent by the Sub-agent, at the expense of the applicant, and if the land applied for is vacant on receipt of the telegram such application is to have priority and the land will be held until the necessary papers to complete the transaction are received by mail.

In case of "personation" or fraud the applicant will forfest all priority of claim or if entry has been granted it will be silk. Made to wear and keep ummarily cancelled.

An application for cancellation must be made in person. The applicant must be ligible for homestead entry, and only one application for cancellation will be received from an individual until that application has been disposed of.

Where an entry is cancelled subsequent to institution of cancellation proceedings, the applicant for cancellation will be entitled to prior right of entry.

Applicant for cancellation must state in what particulars the homesteader is in default.

A homesteader whose entry is not the bject of cancellation proceedings may subject to the approval of Department, relinquish it in favor of father mother, son, daughter, brother or sister if eligible, but to no one else, on filing declaration of abandonment.

DUTIES—A settler is required to perform the duties under one of the following plans:—

(1) At least six months' residence up-on and cultivation of the land in each year during the term of three years.
(2) A homesteader may, if he so desires, perform the required residence duties by living on farming land owned solely by him, not less than eighty (80) acres in extent, in the vicinity of his estead. Joint ownership in land will

not meet this requirement.

(3) If the father (or mother, if the father is deceased) of a homesteader has permanent residence on farming land owned solely by him, not less than eighty (80) acres in extent, in the vicinity of the homestead, or upon a homestead entered for by him in the vicinity, such homesteader may perform his own residence duties by living with the father (or mother.) father (or mother.)

(4) The term "vicinity" in the two
preceding paragraphs is defined as meanng not more than nine miles in a direct

line exclusive of the width of road alwance crossed in the measurement.

(5) A homesteader intending to perform
his residence duties in accordance with
the above while living with parents or
on farming land owned by himself must
notify the Agent for the district of such
intention. Before making application for patent he settler must give six months notice in writing to the Commissioner of Do-minion Lands at Ottawa, of his inter-

SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH WEST MINING REGULATIONS. COAL—Coal mining rights may be leased for a period of twenty-one years an annual rental of \$1 per acre. Not the than 2,560 acres shall be leased to the individual or company. A royally at the rates of five cents per ton shall be pllected on the merchantable coal mined. QUARTZ—A person eighteen years of ice or over, having discovered mineral in lace, may locate a claim 1,500x1,500 of cet.

The fee for recording a claim is \$5.

At least \$100 must be expended on the claim each year or paid to the mining recorder in lieu thereof. When \$500 has been expended or paid, the locator may upon having a survey made, and upon complying with other requirements, purchase the land at \$1 per acre.

The patent provides for the payment of a royalty of 24 per cent on the sales.


