Death of Warren Meacham - J. W. Yeomans Becomes a Lay Missionary on St. Joseph's Island. Newburgh, May 7. - Rev. R. Duke surprised the quarterly board of the Methodist church at their meeting on Monday last by announcing to them that he felt it necessary to ask the conference for relief from work for one year, necessitating his severance of connection with the church here, after only one year's service.
