## A LATE DISCOVERY

### ONE OF SEVEN VICTIMS WAS A WOMAN.

Substantiates Theory That Couple Who Called For Jennie Olsen Were Murdered.

Laporte, Ind., May 20.—Autopsies of the seven unidentified bodies exhumed from Mrs. Belle Guiness' private burial ground were completed to-day, and they reveal the facts, according to the reports of Drs. Wilcox and Osborne, who conducted the autopsies under the direction of Coroner Mack, that one of the seven was a female.

This revelation aroused new interest in the story that a man and a woman came to the house on night in 1901 to take Jennie Olsen to a Los Angeles college, as Mrs. Guiness told those about the place. In view of the offer of the county commissioners to pay \$4,000 for the production of Mrs. Guiness alive, Prosecutor Smith expects that this search will be world-wide.

The Ogress Perished.

Laporte, Ind., May 20.—The upper and lower plates of artificial teeth from the mouth of Mrs. Belle Guiness were found, to-day, in the ashes of the Guiness home. "This proves beyond the shadow of a doubt," said Sheriff Smutler, "that Mrs. Guiness was burned to death in the fire." I. H. Norton, who made the lower plate, positively identified it. He also identified the upper plate, having frequently seen it, although it was made before he became Mrs. Guiness' dentist.

The issuing of a certificate of death of Jennie Olson and the turning over of the body, by Coroner Mack, to her relatives in Chicago, puts the official stamp of identification upon one of the bodies found at the Guiness farm regarding which there has been much controversy.
