

Synopsis of Canadian Northwest HUMESTEAD REGULATIONS.

MY even-numbered section of Doe minion Lands in Manitoba or the Borthwest Provinces, excepting 8 and 26, not reserved, may be homestendor by any person the sole head of a family, or male over 18 tyears of age, to the extent of one-quarter section, of 160 acres, more or less.

Application for homestead entry must De made in person by the applicant at a Dominios Landa Agency or Sub-agency. Entry by proxy may, however, be made at an Agency on certain conditions by the father, mother, son, daughter, brother or ister of an intending homesteader.

An application for cancellation must be made in person. The applicant must be eligible for homestead entry. DUTIES,-(1) At least six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year during the term of three years,

(2) A homesteader may, if he so de-sires, perform the required residence du-ties by living on farming land owned solely by him, not less than eighty (80) acres in extent, in the vicinity of his homestead. Joint ownership in land will

(3) If the father (or mother, if the father is deceased) of a homesteader had permanent residence on farming land wheel solely by him, not less than eight— (80) acres in extent, in the vicinity of the homestead, or upon a homestead entered for by him in the vicinity, such homestead and the second residences have perform him away remidences. steader may perform his awn residence duties by living with the father (or (4) The term "vicinity" in the two preceding paragraphs is defined as means
