Chemical Now Used to Eradicate Yellow Flower.

The North Dakota station has been experimenting in methods of destroying the dandelion in lawns. As a result of these experiments it is stated that this pest may be eradicated in blue grass lawns, in parks, in mea-dows and on roadsides without injury to the grass resulting from the use of the chemical employed in the work of

In order to keep the dandelions out it is necessary to spray at intervals of ore month or six weeks throughout the growing period of the year. For ordinary lawn purposes the ideal spraying apparatus is the compressed air type of hand spraying machine. It is necessary that sufficient pressure be maintained by the pump to make a forceful spray of a fine form. 
