CONDITIONS OF EMIGRATION. Work For Right Men In Canada, Says Glasgow Paper.

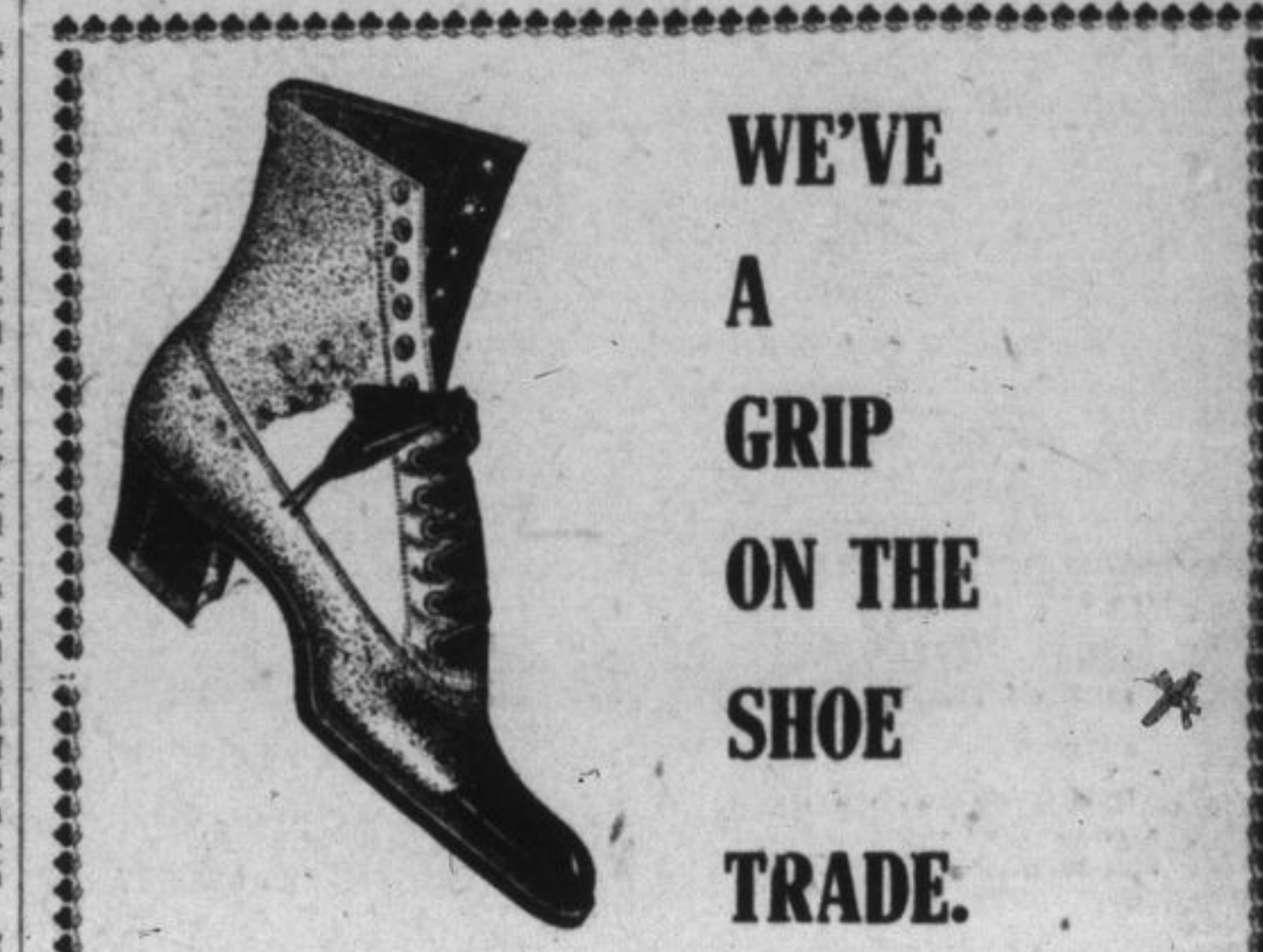

Higgins is said to have made money, and built a row of houses to which he handed on his name."

The parish church of St. Botolph, Boston, England, which was damaged by lightning recently, dates from the 14th century, and is remarkable in more ways than one. Its tower—"Boston's Stump," 272 feet high, with one exception the highest of any parish church in England—contains for many miles across the Lincolnshire fens and over the Wash, contains 365 steps, corresponding to the days of the year.
