THE SUFFRAGIST PARADE AN IMMENSE SUCCESS.



London, June 25.—Ten thousand earnest and determined women, bent on securing the right to vote at parliamentary elections, walking the principal streets of London, in imposing parade, was a sight never before witnessed in the English capital.

The procession was eminently notable for its cosmopolitanism. French, American, German, Dutch and Belgian suffragists marched the three miles uncomplainingly.

Women of title—one, at least, indirectly connected with the blood royal—walked with kitchenmaids; women of wealth, factory workers, nurses and shopgirls—all joined in emphasizing their one ideal.

Many of the marchers had reached their three score years and ten, and looked likely to reach yet another score. Two old persons—Mr. and Mrs. Haslam, both more than eighty—walked with the agile step of youth under the green banner of "Old Friends."

"The proudest moment of my life," said Mr. Haslam, as he explained that his great mission in life, "votes for women," began nearly half a century ago.

Mrs. Despard, as grim and resolute as her world-famous brother, Sir John French, strode out behind the gloomy banner of the Holloway "martyrs." Every step she took, every glance she gave to right or left, seemed to say: "We want the vote, and we mean to have it—whatever the cost may be."

The head of the procession, which extended more than two miles, from start to finish, gave the keynote to the whole. A distinguished quartette they were—Mrs. Fawcett, Dr. Sophie Bryant, Miss Emily Davies and Lady Frances Balfour.

Mrs. Fawcett and Dr. Bryant wore the "mortarboards" and scarlet robes of their "varsity" and across Mrs. Davies' slight figure was thrown a crimson sash that contrasted strangely with the somber black she wore.

"Caps and gowns" appeared in number to make a "varsity" procession. One hundred and fifty graduates came from Gorton, almost all many from Newham, and women who had won degrees from London University marched with them.

"Brains are in the procession, surely," exclaimed Miss Corbett, as she ran up and down the lines to see that everything was running merrily on. There were "brains," indeed—brains and resolution. Mrs. Sarah Grand was there, and Miss Beatrice Harraden, who thrilled the reading public with her "Ships That Pass in the Night." Miss Cicely Hamilton, the author of "Dianna of Dobson's," was followed closely by Mrs. Thomas Hardy, the wife of the man whose Wessex tales have become English classics.
