John Nicholson, of Sunbury, Suicided on Friday Afternoon—He Was Evidently Prostrated By Heat.

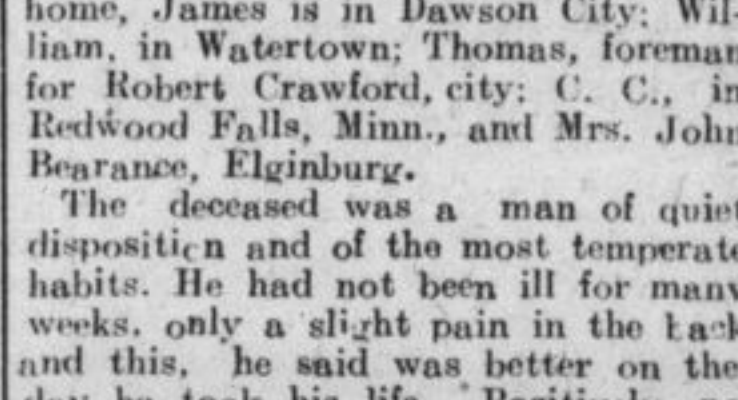
On Friday evening about six o'clock, the body of John Nicholson, Sunbury, was found hanging to a tree back of his house, by his youngest son.
