





The general unrest in Belgrade has been augmented by the discovery that Austrian officers in disguise have been photographing all the principal forts in Servia, especially the fortifications in Belgrade.

One of these officers had in his pos session a secret detailed map of the lines of communication which was supposed to be kept only at the headquarters of the Servian general stalf. Nevertheless, the possibility of Austria sending troops into Servia in the event of the government being overthrown is not sufficient to force the people to help King Peter's efforts to prevent a crisis.

King Peter I, of Servia, was elected to the throne just five days after the terrible assassination of King Alexander and Queen Draga in the palace at Belgrade, on June 10th, 1903. He is the head of the family of Karageorgevitch, which once ruled in

Servia, but was driven out of the country by the Obrenovitchs in 1869. The newly-elected king arrived in Belgrade on June 24th, 1903, and was enthusiastically received by the people The Russian and Austrian ministers were the only members of the diplo matic corps who attended. His coronation took place on September 21st of the following year


