LETTER TO THE EDITOR SHOULD THE HEALTH ACT BE AMENDED?

Taking Objection to a Statement By the Editor of the Whig - Dr. Evans Makes Explanations.

Kingston, Aug. 19. (To the Editor: In your issue of yesterday you published the following editorial note: "The Board of Health act needs amendment. At present any expense can be contracted by its members, or any two of them, and the council has no alternate than pay the bills. This is simply outrageous.")

At a time when public attention is drawn more than usual to the work and proceedings of the local board of health, an editorial note such as the above is of more than passing significance.

In the first place, allow me to show you the error of your position in presuming that the financial affairs of the local board of health are unrestricted or not limited.

There is nothing in this section of the public health act which would justify members of a local board of health contracting expenses indiscriminately. Money can only be paid out on order for services rendered by virtue of the act.

The term, "Any expense can be contracted," is what I object to in your editorial note. It implies that the powers of the board of health are unlimited. It suggests that they are able to do as they please with the money of the taxpayer.

The board of education is another body whose expenditures are not controlled by the city council, and yet there is no suggestion of "outrage" in connection with the liberty of this organization. Do you mean to infer that they are more careful of the privilege they enjoy, or more capable of enjoying it than the board of health?

Coming at this particular time, your note is calculated to injure the board of health in the estimation of the people which it is honestly and unflinchingly endeavoring to serve, and I feel incumbent upon myself as a member of the board to counteract its influence.

For the past six months or so we have been forced to maintain an isolation hospital in the city, and this with all the consequent expenditures has caused the board to exceed the pittance sum of \$80, placed to its credit by the city council at the beginning of the year.

Just think of the generosity of the council that will grant a board of health the silly sum of \$80 to take care of the health of a city with a population of over 20,000 people.

Such things as beds, bedding, cooking utensils, stoves, tents, house-keeping material, medicines, vaccine virus, delicacies for the sick, pay for ambulance hire, &c., for fifteen cases, and yet we have been able to keep the expenditure down to the low level of about \$108 per case, each case causing a detention of at least 42 days in the isolation hospital, and having to equip that hospital with everything it needed, with this expense figured into the total outlay and cost of treating these cases.

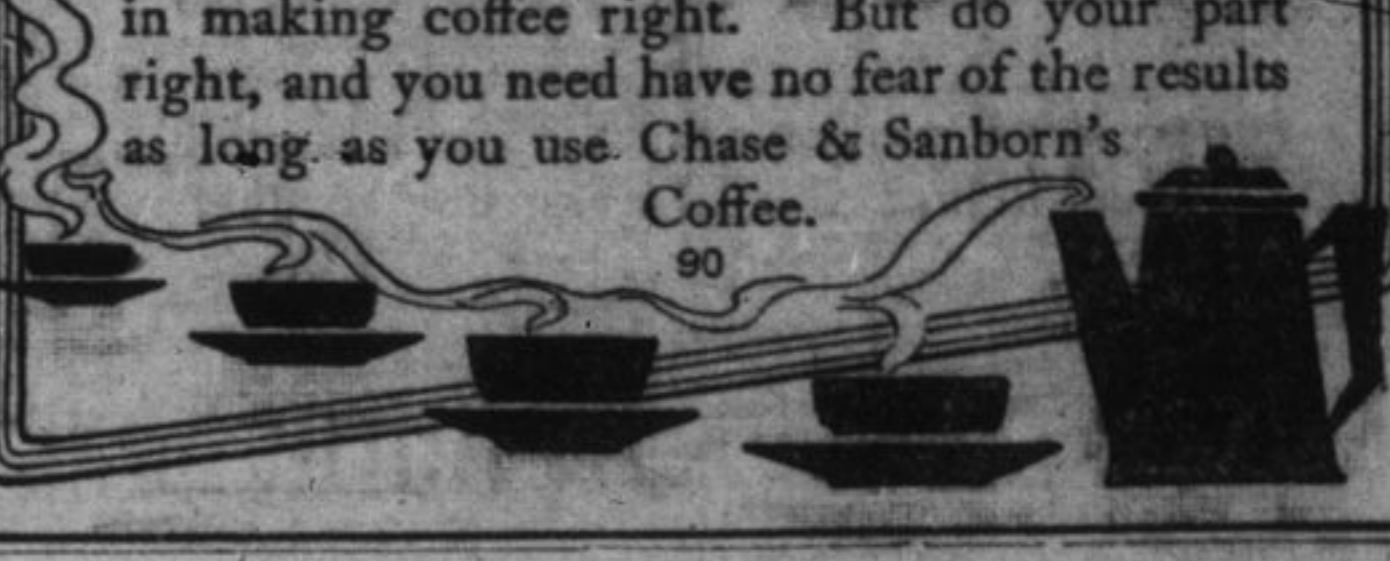
