Synopsis of Canadian Northwest Land Regulations.

ANY PERSON WHO IS THE SOLE head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter-section (160 acres, more or less) of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta.

LEASING FOR TWENTY YEARS AT AN ANNUAL rental of \$1.00 an acre. Not more than 2,500 acres can be leased to one applicant. Royalty, five cents per acre.

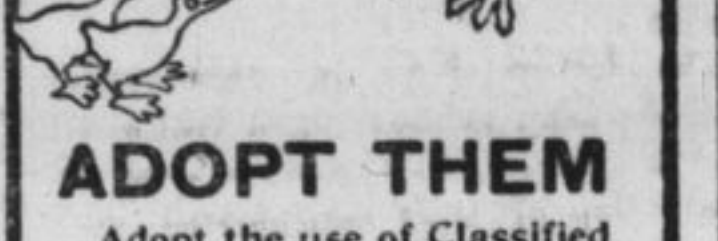
