PRINCE FRANCIS FERDINAND. Vienna, Nov. 29.—The impression is gaining ground that the Austrian empire is moving rapidly toward radical changes. This year has seen the old order giving place to the new in many quarters. Turkey, by her revolution, has entered upon an era of constitutionalism, and Germany's evolutions in the same direction have been hastened by the impulsiveness of the Kaiser's rule. Now it is Austria's turn.

THE RIVERS OVERFLOW AND GREAT DAMAGE DONE IN OKLAHOMA.

Railway Traffic Has Been Practically Abandoned—The Narrow Escape of a Railway Train.

Guthrie, Okla., Nov. 29.—Five persons are dead as the result of five days' rain and overflow of Oklahoma and Northern Texas rivers and land tributaries. Thousands are homeless and hundreds of residences are flooded. Railway traffic has been practically abandoned in Central Oklahoma. A bridge on the Missouri, Oklahoma & Gulf railway, between Muskogee and Waggoner, was washed away a few minutes after a passenger train had crossed. The total loss will exceed \$20,000,000.

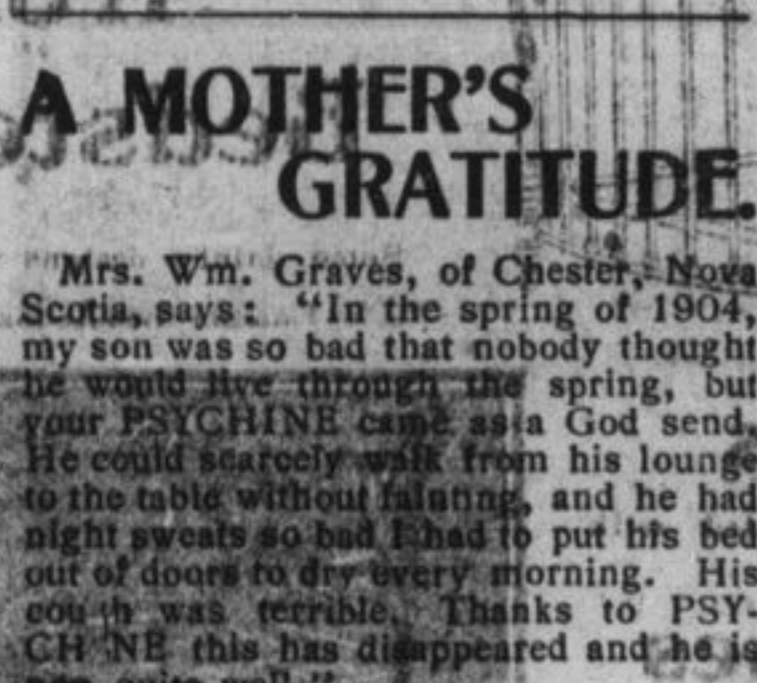

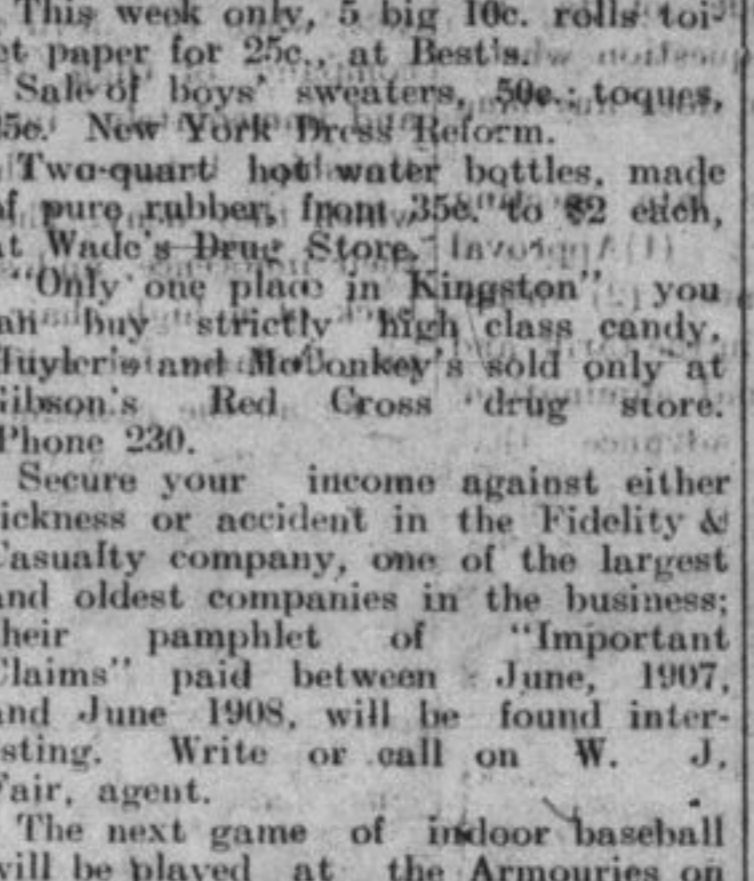
