**LET THE CROOKS OFF AN ECHO FROM THE QUEBEC TER-CENTENARY.**

**Men Told They Would Be Let Leave the Country if They Plead Guilty—They Did So, But Got Five Years Instead.**  
Ottawa, Jan. 29.—An echo from the Quebec ter-centenary is an application to the department of justice for the release of Jacob Cohen and Abraham Glyck, both of New York, who were sentenced each to five years in the penitentiary for pocket-picking. The ground for the petition is that many arrests for this crime were made during the ter-centenary and those arrested, who were Americans, were allowed to go on condition that they at once left the country. When these two men were arrested, according to the petition, they were informed that if they pleaded guilty they would be treated as the others and allowed to go provided they left the country. In order to avoid the trouble of a trial they agreed to plead guilty and were surprised when they were sentenced to five years. They were accused of picking pockets on Dufferin Terrace, Quebec, during the celebration. They asked to be allowed to go on ticket of leave provided they agreed to return to the United States at once.  
The division of the work of the railway commission is only in regard to inspector of accidents. All the other work will be done by the full board together.  
A peculiar situation was discovered, to-day, when W. F. Maclean was found not to be on any standing committee of the commons. He had made application, said the conservator, for a whip, which he called his third party. Sir Wilfrid Laurier, however, placed his name down to serve as usual.  
The deputation of the Engineers' Club, from Toronto, consisting of Messrs. A. B. Barry, R. B. Wolsely, R. J. King and Fielding, asked Sir Wilfrid Laurier, to-day, to place a Canadian upon the board for the rebuilding of the Quebec bridge. Sir Wilfrid asked them to suggest a name. If that were done he would give the matter consideration.
