MAY TURN SCRUB PINE TO GOOD USE.

Experiments Lead to the Belief That Long Useless Wood Can Be Manufactured Into Paper.

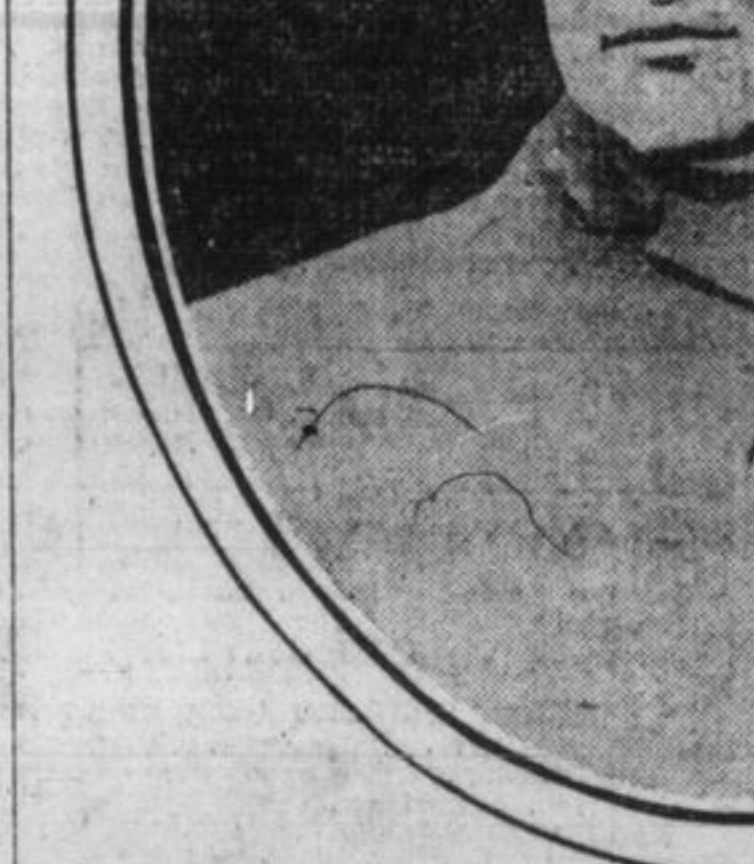
Washington, March 18.—The long neglected scrub of Jersey pine, growing on abandoned farms and cut over land of the east, seems destined at last, the forestry bureau reports, to have reached its rightful place as a material of value.

Scrubs pine might have been used to good advantage long ago, but it did not seem to the practical papermaker worthy of trial.

One advantage for papermaking which scrub pine is said to have is in the fact that there is less loss in barking it than with ordinary spruce.

Practical papermakers who have seen this product are almost unanimous in claiming it to be a strong, long fibered, and hard wearing pulp, which seems especially desirable for making bag, news and wrapping papers.

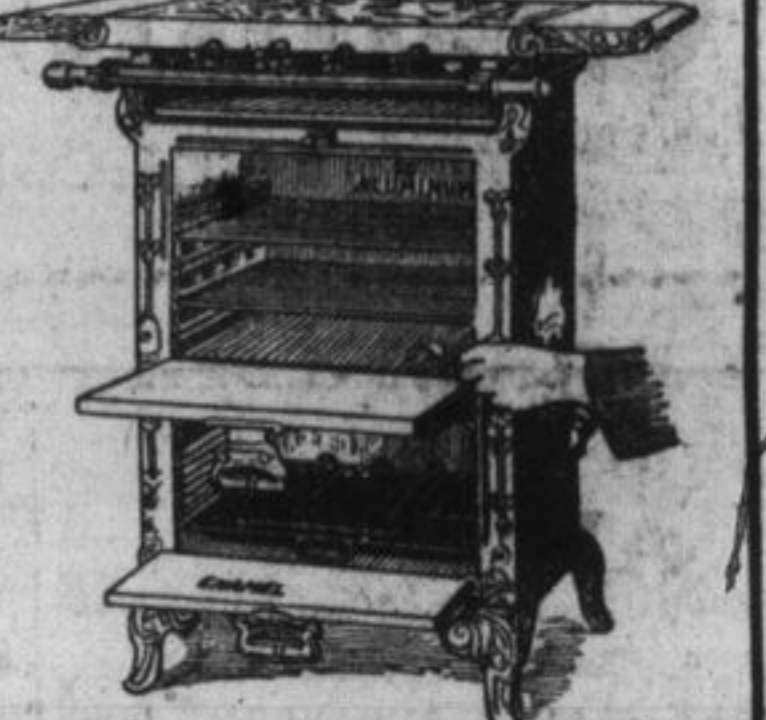
