THINK THEY CAN BEAT THE RECORD MADE.

On Saturday afternoon another batch of runners will try to lower the time set by Cadet Watts for the Nelles shield. The race will be run in the morning over the same course as previous runners have used. A few men from Queen's have entered for the go, and are quite sure that they can bring the shield from the Royal Military College to Queen's. A number of unattached runners from around the city have been covering the distance quite frequently and have made very good time. The present record is 31:32 minutes, held by Cadet Watts, and he ran it over snow, in a very cold wind.

Ready For Play.
The Victoria baseball team will have its first workout at Victoria Park on Saturday afternoon. All the players are requested to be on hand and commence work in earnest. Manager Trotter has some good men signed, and the Vics bid fair to come out near the top this year. The other city league teams will commence to work out the first of next week, as the grounds are not yet dry enough to permit it. Two city teams already have application in for the game on Victoria Day. Both are good ones and would put up quite a game. The matter will be considered at the next meeting of the general sports committee.

Lacrosse Enthusiasts.
The lacrosse players are beginning to turn out slowly. Each evening a squad is out at the cricket field getting in a little practice. A few new men have been discovered but have not been presented yet. From present appearances this year's team should be a good one and if a league is formed the locals should get a good piece of it. Hugh Macdonnell will likely hold down a home position on the team.

The different association football teams are getting in shape for the summer. The Wanderers, or some of last year's Wanderers, are out at the cricket field every day rounding into shape. They play a fast game and are improving daily. The Battery team is also at work and will be heard from shortly. They will likely enter a league with locals and teams from surrounding towns, if one is formed.

May Play On Saturday.
The baseball game between two Queen's teams composed of town boys and out-of-town boys will likely be played on Saturday afternoon at the cricket field. The game was to have been played on Good Friday but was called off on account of the weather. It is an annual affair and the college simply couldn't close without its coming off.

John D. Marsh, Winnipeg, has announced that he will run in the Canadian Marathon race at Hanlan's Point on May 1st. Marsh runs Jackson in Midland on Friday and Fred Meadows at Guelph on Tuesday.
