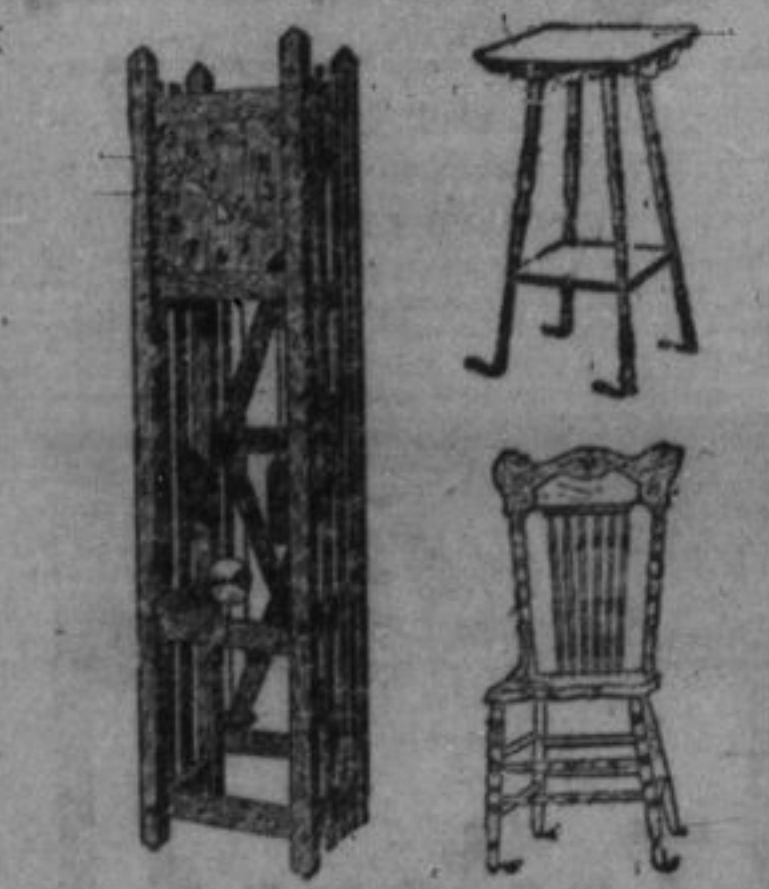

THE VALEDICTORIES

READ AT A STUDENTS' GATHERING ON TUESDAY.

The Arts Valedictorian Suggested That Students Should Be Put on Their Honor at Examinations, Instead of Being Watched.

Old Convocation hall at Queen's was well filled with students and their friends on Tuesday afternoon when the valedictory addresses were delivered.

At two o'clock the chairman, J. H. Stead, B.A., president of the A.M.S., called the meeting to order.

The valedictorians from the different faculties spoke in the following order: Divinity, J. P. Jewitt; arts, H. W. Macdonnell; medicine, D. B. Cameron, M.A.; science, O. M. Perry.

The address of Mr. Jewitt consisted of expression of appreciation for kindness of professors and city people who had opened their doors to the students during their courses.

As for criticism, he stated that the final year appreciated the innovation of Prof. Laird in connection with the trial sermons, which are a part of the course in theology.

H. M. Macdonnell spoke of the far-reaching influence of the university, the arts course being proclaimed in the opinion of the students as second to none in Canada.

Mr. Macdonnell made an important suggestion regarding the conduct at examinations, pointing out that while students were self-relying in most matters, they had not taken control of actions during examinations.
