Synopsis of Canadian Northwest Land Regulations.

THE SOLE head of a family of any male over 15 years old, who has homesteaded a quarter section (160 acres), more or less, in Saskatchewan or Alberta.

The applicant must appear in person at the district office. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, or in the field, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

DUTIES.—Six months upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live with his family on his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter section alongside his homesteaded 160-acre section. This pre-emption may be made in any of the following sections:

QUARTZ.—Quartz veins of five miles in length may be leased for a term of 20 years. Rental, \$10 a mile per annum. Royalty, 2 1/2 per cent on the output exceeds \$10,000.
