REVISION OF BIBLE

The Latin Text and the Work of the Pope's Commission.

Two years ago announcement was made of the Pope's intention to revise the Latin Bible, and the work has made good progress. The need for revision of the work involved has prevented private enterprise, from making anything more than tentative efforts in a very limited field.

The object is to determine and restore the original text of St. Jerome's Latin translation made in the fourth century. How far St. Jerome's translation represents the Hebrew or Greek is another question, possibly another commission. For to-day the task of its accurate reproduction is sufficient.
