HAD AN ACCIDENT. Belleville Boys Were Both Wounded.

Belleville, Ont., Sept. 23.—Two well-known boys of this city were victims of a shooting accident Tuesday afternoon. Frederick Mills and Bert Bell, both thirteen years of age, took a holiday and went out into the country a few miles from the city, in search of squirrels. While crawling through a tall fence they stepped on a pile of stones, which began to move under their feet. Both boys fell to the ground, the trigger of the gun carried by Bell striking a stone and discharging the weapon. The bullet entered Mills' thigh and passed through Bell's right thumb. Mills was removed to the hospital and will recover.

PIGS ATTACK TWO MEN. James R. Hosken Killed at Chilli-wack, B.C.

Vancouver, B.C., Sept. 23.—James R. Hosken, son of Rev. Mr. Hosken, Crosswell, Mansfield, Eng., lost his life at Chilli-wack under terrible circumstances. He was employed by Charles Carter, a farmer, in driving pigs to market on Saturday, when the drove became uncontrollable and attacked Messrs. Hosken and Carter. Mr. Hosken was knocked down and terribly lacerated by the tusks of the infuriated animals. The boys were finally driven off and medical aid procured. Mr. Hosken died, yesterday, as a result of the loss of blood and shock. He was twenty-five years of age and a recent arrival.

DEER ARE PLENTIFUL. Present Season is the Best in Many Years.

Gouverneur, N.Y., Sept. 23.—Hunters returning from the Adirondacks report that not in years have deer been so numerous as they are this season. In the vicinity of Gouverneur many straggle deer have been seen and several have been killed.

William Corbin, of this village, killed a large buck on the Copley tract near Antwerp, yesterday, and he reports that many deer have been seen in that vicinity within the past few days.

Several hunting parties from Gouverneur are now in the Adirondacks, and reports have been received from them stating that they have bagged several deer and that many have been seen.

POISONED BY RAT. Animal Seized Des Moines Woman By Throat.

Des Moines, Ia., Sept. 23.—Mrs. Maggie Bates, of 1230 Woodland avenue, considers herself fortunate that she did not lose her right arm as the result of being bitten on the thumb by a rat.

Several days ago Mrs. Bates put rat poison in some corn husks in the basement of her home. A couple of days afterward she started to pick up the husks to throw them in the furnace. A rat concealed behind the blood-poisoning set in and for a time her condition was very serious, but it is now thought that amputation of the thumb may not be necessary.

SEES IN TELEPHONE. Mexico City, Sept. 23.—Alberto Sanchez, an electrical engineer, at present an inmate of Belem prison, claims to have invented an apparatus whereby vision as well as voice may be transmitted over an ordinary telephone wire. He calls his invention a tele-ophthicon, and the prison officials admit that successful tests have been made with models. It is said the contrivance resembles short opera-glasses attached to a battery.

MET SHERIFF WITH AXE. Woman Drove Off Officer, Who Flew in Haste.

Edmonton, Sept. 23.—When Sheriff Robertson attempted to serve a writ of replevin on Mrs. John Moran he was met at the door by the lady in person, who brandished an axe. The result was that the officer fled, waiting only long enough to assure himself that Mrs. Moran meant business. The woman and her husband have been estranged for some time, and the writ was on the husband's private belongings.

Plotting To Extort Money. Chicago, Sept. 23.—On bench warrants issued here J. G. Hazelton, p. an attorney, and L. Scott Kempner, an actor, both of New York, were arrested. The complainants are Mr. and Mrs. James H. Channon, who declare the men have plotted to extort \$100,000 from them.
