

**GOOD TOWNSHIP FAIR**

EVERY ONE PLEASED WITH THE EXHIBITS.

Victoria's Defeated Locos at Base-ball 15 to 4. Two Horse Races, Green and Grey. Mr. Ali Keeney Contested.

The first day of the Kingston township fair was a success from all points of view. No doubt the weather had quite a little to do with the crowd, but the rain held off well, only a few very slight showers coming late in the afternoon, and not enough to do any damage. The crowd was very large for the first day of the fair, and the different exhibits were viewed with interest, many complimentary remarks being passed about the size, quality, and arrangement of the different articles shown. The large palace where the perishable goods were shown was the main attraction and drew large crowds. Everyone was exceptionally well pleased with the show made in all branches.

The live stock exhibit was fine, especially in the horse grades, and was far ahead of any other line shown at any of the district fairs this season. The military transport show was good, twenty-five teams lining up, along the green to be judged. Lieut.-Col. Hemming, D.O.C., was judge of this class and had a hard time picking a winner, so close was the competition. In the other classes the competition was also very close. The cattle, sheep and pigs were well represented.

The following were judges: Horses, G. W. Ruddick, government inspector; cattle, R. Shannon and Mr. Ferguson; sheep and pigs, M. Travers; F. Ferguson; poultry, George H. Hunter; grain, W. McNeil; vegetables, R. Barden, P. G. Edwards; fruit, W. O'Shen, Joshua Knight; dairy products, J. Crawford; ladies' work, Mrs. S. A. Lyons, Mrs. F. S. Ferguson.

In regard to amusement plenty was furnished for the people, a fine baseball match, in which the Victorians defeated the Locos, 15 runs to 4, and two fast and close horse races. Both drew large crowds, the people being packed around the diamond and the grand stand being well filled with the lovers of the sport. The Odessa band was in the stand and furnished excellent music.

"Buck" is one of the best shortstops in the league, and the Vics could have used him handily all season in the same place.
