

### ASTRONOMERS WATCH MARS AT CLOSE RANGE.



WATCHING MARS AT GREENWICH FROM THE SPHERE

The planet Mars, says the Sphere, being now in unusual proximity to the earth, is a prominent object in the heavens the greater part of the night. Mars is due south (on the meridian) about midnight and is two million miles nearer than when Mr. Percival Lowell observed it in 1907 from this great observatory in Arizona. This brilliant amateur astronomer claims to have seen canals in Mars and thus to have established the fact that there are beings on the planet; if so, these enormous canals would show greater engineering capacity than we on the earth possess. Few astronomers, however, accept his theory. Our artist when he was in the observatory (Greenwich) was struck by the solemn stillness of the place while the astronomers are at work on their delicate observations. The room, of course, is quite in the dark except for the light which creeps in from the night sky and the little electric lamp which enables one of the observers to make notes in his observation book.

Despite many appeals, and it was reported, against the wish of Pope Pius X., Dr. Francisco Ferrer, a Spanish radical, was shot to death in Barcelona.

The news of the execution of the sentence of death imposed by the court-martial caused an outbreak of angry protest over Continental Europe, serious rioting taking place in Paris and Rome. In the French capital ten thousand men made a demonstration against the Spanish Embassy. The rioters fired a volley of shots at M. Lepine, Prefect of Police, when he appeared to quell the outbreak. M. Lepine narrowly escaped death.
