A CONCISE SUMMING UP. That the unionist candidate won in the Bermondsey election has given the party a great deal of satisfaction.

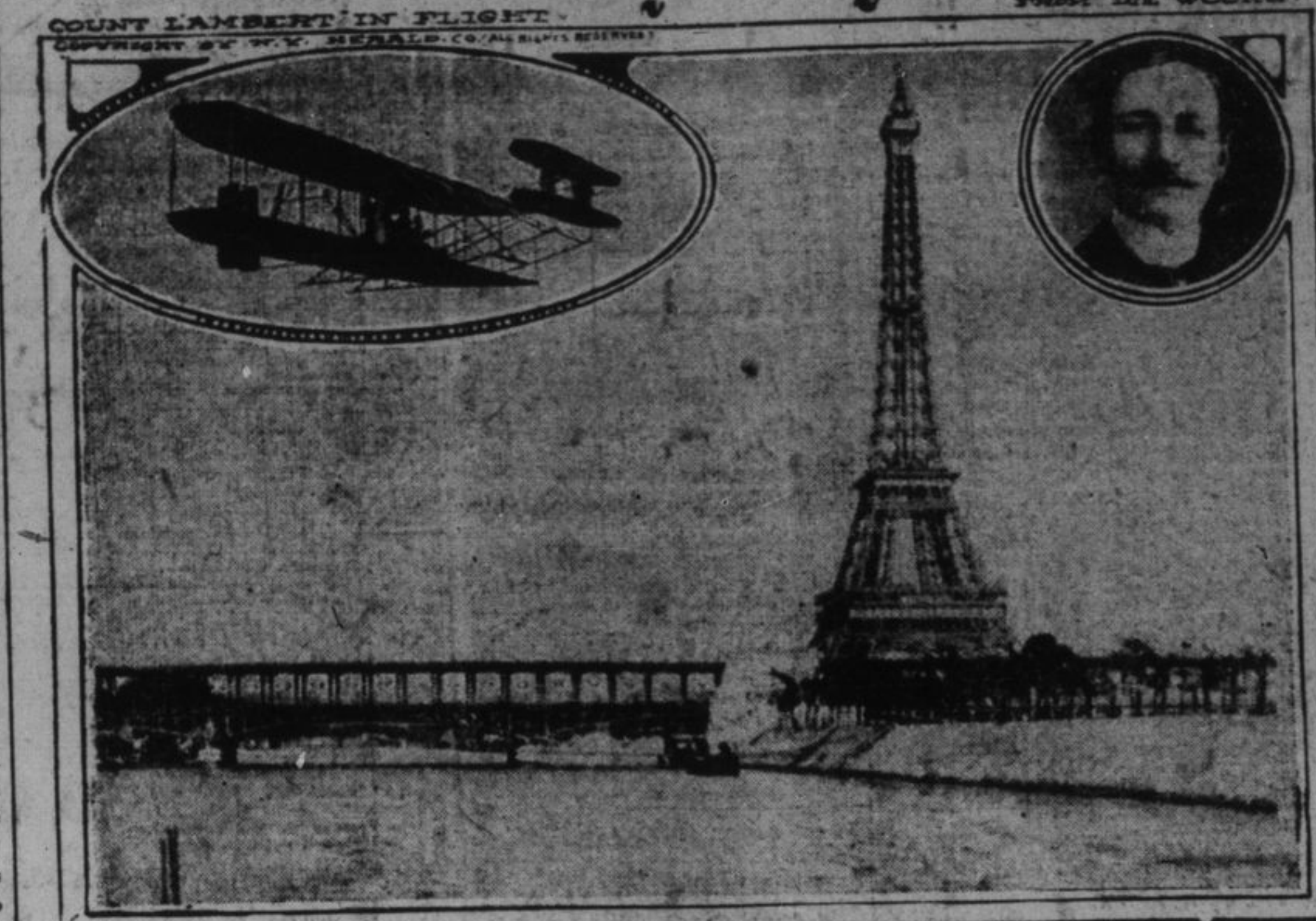
The Toronto board of education thinks it should have a superintendent of its work Mr. Hughes to be retired on a pension. But this same board is never happy unless it is quarrelling over something.
