DRIVES LIQUOR FROM DIVES. Second Crusade Planned to Abolish District. Chicago, Feb. 24.—To curb the gloom of temperance workers resulting from "dry" petitions and Mayor Buse's ban on liquor selling in resorts, the United Societies announce a plan for a monster parade in protest. Fully 30,000 men, fearing Chicago eventually will go "dry," will march through the loop district. The "wets" are determined to eclipse the efforts of temperance marshes recently when Gen. Frederick Dent Grant headed the column.

HAVE HAD A CLASH. It is Feared Forces Cannot be Re- strained. Sofia, Feb. 24.—News has reached here of a serious clash between the Turkish and Bulgarian frontier troops in the Taurish district in which several, on both sides, were killed. No details of the fighting have been received. Bulgaria has more than 40,000 troops massed in the Kostene and Dubatza districts and there is grave fear they may commit some other act that will precipitate a Turkey-Bulgarian struggle before Bulgaria is ready for it. The government is investigating the outbreak.

Loses Ten Million in Oil War. London, Feb. 24.—Government leaders have decided to hold in abeyance the raising of Sir William Pearson to the peerage of Lord Curzon, pending the untangling of his financial affairs. The great English engineering firm of S. Pearson & Son, limited, last year lost \$10,000,000 in contesting with the Waters Pierce Oil company for supremacy in Mexico in the oil business. Both sides have adopted a singular "one quarter" and price-cutting will continue until one side or the other is annihilated.

Duluth, Minn., Feb. 24.—Father Timothy Corbett, of the Sacred Heart cathedral, Duluth, has made a stinging arraignment of the Y.M.C.A. The rumored remarks of Father Corbett were made in his discourse at the cathedral. He said in part: "They ask you to barter the precious heritage of twenty centuries for a shower bath."

Helms to Fortune Found.

Birmingham, Ala., Feb. 24.—In 1802 E. D. Ennis, who was a suitor of Mrs. Claudie Yester, then Miss Claudie Clark, shot a man and fled. He went to Jamaica, where he amassed a fortune. Three years ago he was fatally injured in a fight with a Spaniard and before dying willed his fortune of \$350,000 to "Miss Clark." Daniel Jones, alcalde of Jamaica, has just located Mrs. Yester at Nashville, Tenn., and she will receive the fortune. The governor of Jamaica had offered a reward of \$1,000 for information of her whereabouts.

Poachers' Feathers Seized.

Washington, Feb. 24.—Twenty-three Japanese have been arrested and turned over to the United States marshal at Honolulu for illegally gathering and storing birds' feathers and wings from the Laysan and Lisianski islands of the Hawaiian group. Capt. W. A. E. Jacobs, of the revenue cutter Thetis, has seized feathers and wings valued at \$112,740. Capt. Jacobs says about 300,000 birds have been slaughtered by the plumage hunters.

Friends Find Man a Wife.

Duquoin, Ill., Feb. 24.—Recently Henry C. Haek promised his friends he would marry. If they would find some woman willing to have him and the county clerk and judge would perform their services free. Haek's friends succeeded and he has just been married to Miss Lizzie Gilbert, of Vergennes, Ill.

Has 100 Great-Grandchildren.

Byron, Ok., Feb. 24.—Mrs. Anna Evans, who has just celebrated her ninety-seventh birthday, has four children living, thirty-two grandchildren and an hundred great-grandchildren. Her husband, Rev. Solomon Evans, died at Ravensmo, Mo., sixty-one years ago. Her eldest son, Harvey Evans, is seventy-three years old.
