A homesteader may live within five miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres, solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section of his homestead. Price \$9.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside six months of three years at cultivation. Date of homestead entry (including the time required to acquire homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres of the interior. A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead right and cannot obtain a pre-emption may take a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$9.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside six months of three years at cultivation. Price \$9.00 per acre and erect a house worth \$500.00.
