ANY person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, may homestead a quarter-section of "virgin" Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Land Agency or Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, on certain conditions, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader. Duties—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may own or control at least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister. In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may purchase a quarter-section alongside his homesteaded farm, \$3.00 per acre. For full details see notice in back of this year's Directory.
