GANANOQUE TRIALS

ITS LITTLE TRAIN CAUSED MANY SAD HEARTS.

Engine Ran Off Track and People Missed Train at Junction—Crying Out for a Better Service.

Gananoque, March 27.—The travelling public of this town were again up against a hard condition on Saturday morning, as the 1.1. R. train pulled out of the lower station at 8.10 with some 75 passengers on board, bound for points east and west to spend the holiday, an equal number of passengers were in waiting at the AUGUST STREET pavilion, when on reaching the next station, not fifty yards from the station building the track spread at the "frog" and the tender ran out, both fore and hind truck and the front wheels of the front truck on the passenger car. A ferry up call was made to the various liveries of the town, who could only furnish five hacks for the occasion, taking about half of the number out to the junction. The remainder having no possible means of conveyance had to go back home, this might have been had enough by itself, but did not finish the tale of woe. Three of the hacks reached the junction in due time and the occupants gauged their trains, but the other two hacks, arriving later found both trains gone and nothing for it, but having paid 25c a head for the privilege of riding out to pay a similar price for the pleasure of riding back. Some rather strong epithets were used against the local line, and strong wishes that some company would soon take the road over and furnish suitable transportation service for the people of this town. The company at once got busy to get the tender and coach on the track, which was done and the afternoon connections made, but the citizens who had intended going away had by that time decided to remain at home.
