TOWN OF GANANOQUE

FUNERAL OF THE LATE W. F. LAQUE.

Salvation Army Officers, Transferred—Gananoque Vault Had a Record Number of Bodies a Week Ago.

Marching orders came during the funeral of the late W. F. Laque, who passed away at St. Agathe, Que., on Thursday evening, arrived here on Saturday afternoon, and the funeral took place from the family residence, King street, yesterday afternoon, to St. John's church, where Libera was sung by Rev. Fr. Kehoe, after which the remains were laid to rest in the Roman Catholic burying ground.

Receipts from the sacred "capitula," "Light Out of Darkness," given under the auspices of Grace Y.E.S., on Thursday evening last, foot up close to \$100.

Gananoque vault a week ago contained the remains of twenty-two persons, the largest known in the history of that institution, which was built about twenty years ago.

Smith's Falls, Ont., April 4.—The death occurred at his home in Perth of William McGarry, sheriff of Lanark county. The deceased, prior to his elevation to the shrievalty, was famous throughout this section as a stock man, and there were few men in the county better known.

Ship Came to a Standstill Over a Bacon Row. Marseilles, April 4.—On the arrival here of the Fraissinet line steamer Pelcon, from Kotonou, Dahomy, the captain reported that the entire crew mutinied in mid-ocean, complaining that they had been made to eat too much bacon.

Man Had Not Moved Since 1875—Is Now Dead. London, April 4.—William G. Parkhouse, aged sixty-five, died here after being continually in bed for thirty-five years.

Dunlop Case in June. Ottawa, April 4.—It is learned that the action in which Andrew R. H. Dunlop, is claiming \$10,000 damages from Ottawa, will be heard here at the June assizes before Chancellor Boyd.
