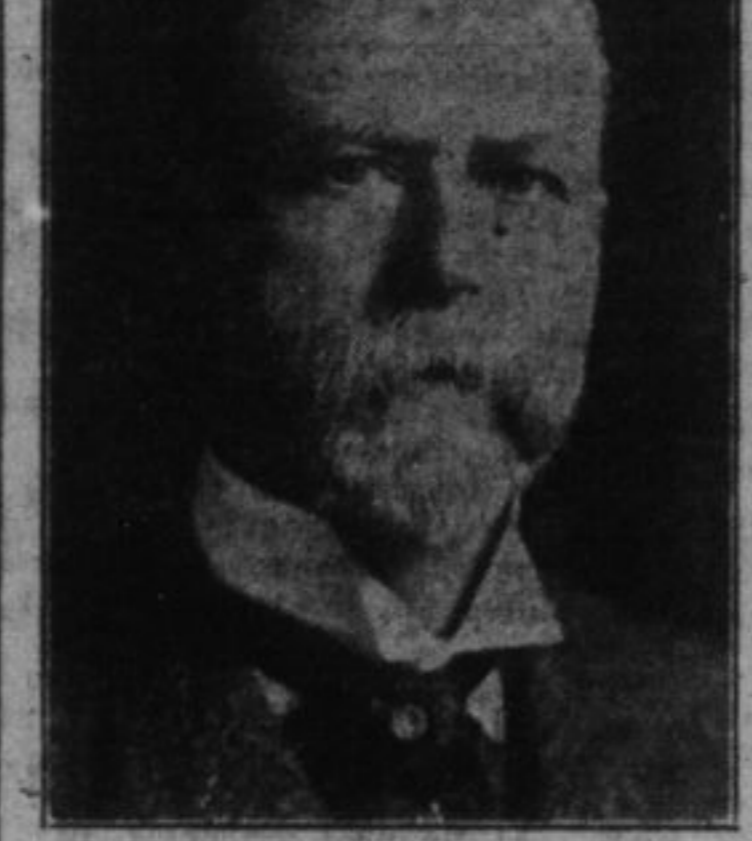

BY THE PUPILS OF THE COLLEGIATE INSTITUTE.

To W. S. Ellis, the Retiring Principal—A Gold-headed Cane and a silk Umbrella Were Presented on Friday.

A pleasant affair took place at the Collegiate Institute, on Friday afternoon, when the retiring principal, W. S. Ellis, M.A., now dean of the faculty of education, at Queen's, was waited on by the pupils and presented with a handsome gold-headed cane, suitable engraved and a beautiful silver-handled silk umbrella, also engraved. The presentation was made on behalf of the scholars by W. Hartley Robinson. In his address Mr. Robinson stated how sorry every student was to hear of Mr. Ellis leaving the institution with which he had been connected so long, but it was pleasant to know that he would not be leaving the city.

Dean Ellis was visibly moved by the kind gift of the pupils, and made a feeling speech in reply, referring to the long time spent in the collegiate and how much he had enjoyed his work, the pupils always trying to make things as easy for him as possible.
