A naval military tournament will tour Canada in 1912. The C.P.R. estimates the north week yield at 91,700,000 bushels.

Ontario grown peaches on sale in London, Eng., are fetching the highest prices of the market.

James F. McEvoy, retired lumber merchant and miller, is dead, at Toronto, aged seventy-six years.

William J. Bryan has announced he cannot support the democratic nominee for governor of New York.

Seven persons were killed and twenty-nine injured by a collision between express train near Rotterdam.

The Prince of Wales and Prince Albert, probably, will tour the world next autumn visiting the principal dominions.

Bedrich Hierbert, a thirteen-year-old boy, has been committed for trial at Gresham, Man., on the charge of murdering his cousin.

Japanese socialists are accused of plotting to assassinate the emperor. The plotters have been arrested and will certainly be put to death.

It is reported the Old Guard republicans, in New York, may propose Senator Roof for temporary chairman of the convention at Saratoga.

The provincial police have been notified of the arrest, at Toledo, of Frank Jackson, a negro, wanted at Chatham on a charge of murder.
