**DIDN'T GIVE NOTICE**

**TO PORTSMOUTH COUNCIL AS LAW PROVIDES.**

**Right of Miss Mary Seager to Sue the Village for Injuries for Damages is Contested—The Plaintiff's Claim.**

The counsel for the village of Portsmouth contends that Miss Mary Seager has no right to sue the village, as she did not give the necessary notice of injury to the council within seven days. Miss Seager is suing for \$500 damages for injuries received by falling on a defective sidewalk in the village. Counsel for the plaintiff will contend that by the saving clause of the act, Miss Seager's failure to give the notice within seven days after the accident, was reasonable. She was in ignorance of the law, and her brother, when he spoke to a Portsmouth councillor about the matter, was advised to wait until the "next meeting of the council." It is also pointed out that in the case of Dr. Jennie Brennan against the city of Kingston, some years ago, Justice Meredith allowed Miss Brennan's action, although notice to the city had not been given as provided by law. It was not given until two days afterwards. In the Portsmouth case, the counsel will argue the point before Judge Price next Tuesday.

**REGISTRATION FOR NURSES.**  
Address Given by Miss Crosby, of Toronto.
